E4RS II - Tip 1: Shock Piston Fixation

On many shock's - of any brand - there is a little play between the piston and his fixation.

For better performances, and perfect control of the shock movements, the piston MUST be perfectly attached to the shaft, without any longitudinal play.

For this reason, I always check the gap between the e-clip and the piston, and if necessary, I simply add a shim (0.1, 0.2 or 0.3mm) between the main washer and the piston, to let zero gap between them.

It's a very easy way to get perfect shock movement control, without a "dead band" due to an undesirable play.
