



E4RS II - Tip 2: Shock Lower Ballcups

With some standard length shock springs - which may be necessary in some track and race conditions - it may be a bit difficult to obtain a correct ride height.

So, I found a very easy way to fix this little problem: I simply cut my shocks lower ballcups on the thin line moulded on them.

With this modification, I can now use any standard length 1/10 TC shock spring (Kfactory, Ride, Spec-R, Tamiya, Yokomo, HPI etc.) without any problem of ride height.
